ADMISSIONS SCHEDULE

Below is a schedule of important dates in the Admission Process for the 2025-2026 school year:

October 16, 2024 Enrollment opens - Applications for the 2025-2026 school year now accepted.

January 13, 2025 FACTS site open to apply for financial aid – apply by May 1, 2025, for financial aid consideration

February 4, 2025 Auto re-enrollment through FACTS for returning students

May 1, 2025 Financial Aid application due for consideration

May 2, 2025 Welcome letters go out for new students

May 16, 2025 Preschool applications submitted after May 16th may be placed in a combined PK3/PK4 classroom

AGE REQUIREMENTS

3 Year old Preschool students must be 3 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2022 or before). 4 Year old Preschool students must be 4 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2021 or before). Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2020 or before).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS - Prior to the first day of school

For transfer students in any grade, you must provide a copy of the student's most current medical, eye, and dental records. NEW exams, as shown below, are required for all students entering the following grades:

PreK 3 & 4 Medical* with the Lead Screening portion completed

Kindergarten Medical* with Lead Screening portion completed, Dental, and Vision/Eye

Grade 2 Dental

Grade 6 Medical* (including proof of new TDap and Meningococcal vaccinations), Dental, and Vision/Eye
